**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN JOSE TERMINATING THE DIRECTOR OF  
EMERGENCY SERVICES' FEBRUARY 3, 2024  
PROCLAMATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL  
EMERGENCY FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY THREAT OF  
HIGH WATER FLOWS AND FLOODING DUE TO THE  
EXTREME STORMS IN JANUARY AND FEBRUARY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San José (“City”) City Council desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated March 8, 2024, from the Director of Emergency Services, Raymond Riordan, for the March 26, 2024, City Council meeting (“Memorandum”); and

**WHEREAS**, the proclamation of a Local Emergency was issued on February 3, 2024, was ratified by the City Council on February 6, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Government Code and the San Jose Municipal Code require the City to terminate the emergency when the threat no longer exists;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

The Proclamation of a local emergency declared by the Director of Emergency Services on February 3, 2024, ratified by the City Council on February 6, 2024, is hereby terminated as the threat to public safety posed by high water flows and flooding no longer exists.
