SUBJECT: Clarity on Issues Related to the Stormwater Permit

RECOMMENDATION

Agendize a discussion with San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board staff during the June 4th Council Meeting.

BACKGROUND

Vice Mayor Kamei and Councilmembers Jimenez, Ortiz, and Candelas recently had the opportunity to engage the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) staff directly regarding the Stormwater Permit review and approval process, including its impact on the City Budget.
