**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN JOSE ADOPTING A “RESOLUTION OF LOCAL
SUPPORT” TO ACCEPT AND RECEIVE GRANT
FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORTATION
PLANNING GRANT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY
MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO NEGOTIATE AND
EXECUTE GRANT AGREEMENTS AND ALL
DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE
GRANT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$221,325 FOR REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE SAN JOSE
TRAVEL MODEL BIG DATA UPDATE**

WHEREAS, the City of San José (“City”) City Council desires to adopt this resolution for the reasons set forth in the memorandum, dated September 16, 2024, from the Director of Transportation John Ristow for the October 8, 2024, City Council meeting (“Memorandum”); and

WHEREAS, in July 2024, the City submitted the San José Travel Models Big Data Update proposal to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for funding consideration under the Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program (STPG); and

WHEREAS, Caltrans recommended that the City be awarded \$221,325 in STPG grant funding for the development of the San José Travel Models Big Data Update; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans requires entering into a grant agreement as part of the grant acceptance process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is asked to adopt a “Resolution of Local Support” which indicates that the City will follow all grant program requirements and delivery

timelines; and authorizes the City Manager or designee to negotiate and execute grant agreements and all documents necessary to effectuate the grant with Caltrans in an amount not to exceed \$221,325 for the development of the San José Travel Models Big Data Update;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN JOSE THAT:

1. The City of San José agrees to follow all grant program requirements and delivery timelines; and
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute grant agreements and all documents necessary to effectuate the Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program with Caltrans for the development of the San José Travel Models Big Data Update in an amount not to exceed \$221,325.
