Subject: Retroactive Purchase of State of the City Award

Background

On October 17, 2023 our office purchased an engraved award for \$183.73 to recognize Valley Transit Authority (VTA) staff for their willingness to provide the VTA-owned Cerone Yard as a site to house emergency interim housing units.
