SEE NEW ITEM 3.7 - RATIFICATION OF PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY, TO BE ADDED UNDER ORDERS OF THE DAY, REQUIRES A DETERMINATION BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL PRESENT AT THE MEETING, OR, IF LESS THAN TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ARE PRESENT AT THE MEETING, A UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THOSE MEMBERS PRESENT THAT THERE IS A NEED TO TAKE IMMEDIATE ACTION AND THE NEED TO TAKE ACTION AROSE AFTER THE POSTING OF THE AGENDA.
